1. The meeting was called to order by Hiral Bhakta, co-chairperson, at 6:38 p.m.

The groups bring their own tables. She said they apply flyers to pizza boxes, and CSUN will broadcast on their radio station. Banners go up September 1-3.   7. Jay Nolan, a community services representative, presented the Logan's Run for Autism Awareness event, October 19th, 2009, in Hansen Dam, near the aquatic center. They currently service over 500 people with 24 hour support. The corporate office is in Mission Hills. The event is a 10, 5, walk and roll from 6 a.m. to 2 p.m. There will be informational booths and newsletters. Sponsors were being requested. They would like to have everything set up before the end of September.
