Did Sylmar Neighborhood Council get billed when it was opened for the people evacuated in the 2008 emergencies? Emergency procedures should be set up-talk to Erlin, Fabian, Tammy and Esteban about how Sylmar High was opened, to facilitate if needed in the future.

It was suggested that a thank you note be sent to Richard Alarcon for undoing the "bundling" of the 41 items on the city budget.
