- 7. Discussion and Possible Action: Olive View Medical Center Expansion Draft Environmental Impact Report. The draft EIR notice states the comment period expires July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019 unless extended.   - Peter: Request for extension was made and just got notice it was extended to July 29. Reviewed most of the document rather quickly. Sent out Exec Summary. Don't understand their phasing (Tier I and Tier II). Don't see road or traffic improvement. DEIR says "no impact".
  - Diane: During SEQA only take comments on their issues, not on other "buckets" Said the Tiers were reversed from what was originally shown the community. (NOP)
  - Bonnie B Can they legally change the procedure from NOP to DEIR?
  - Peter Wrote a statement about this to put on record.
  - Tom CHAPA must be servicing patients by December 31, 2021 so that is a short deadline.
  - Peter Olive View is within our SNC, but County owned. SNC is advisory to City. County will use some City services but this is under County. Outreach was inadequate.
  - Joanne: Residents and community members did not get notified.

- Peter More needs to be done to analyze parking
- Ann ... without impacting the neighborhood
- Tom Fire Station 91 does not meet current National standards.
- Bonnie B Local safety is review. County will continue to collaborate ...
- Tom Sheriff should maybe patrol a larger area rather than needing 911 (3.13.3.1)
- Peter Can't find the horse trails as a community benefit or horse staging area Community Center is another item with no specifics.
- Armando How many floors will Community Center have?
- Mary Heard it was going to be for kids (community center)
- Peter No connection between Olive View Dr and Eldridge
- Diane County needs to be a good neighbor
- Tom Concern about homeless taking up residence in our rural areas and can concern/frighten stakeholders (SB 1152 tracking and discharge planning)
- Cheri Have them provide transportation for people coming so they don't come early and stay in area (without housing) until appointment.
- Diane It is the in-take and out-take procedures that is concerning.
- Peter HospTel (for family waiting while someone in hospital)?
- Joanne Could ask County if they can facilitate a certain amount of beds (i.e., Armory). Maybe Hope of the Valley
- Ann Should tell them about people coming ahead of appointments with nowhere to stay.
- Peter What services does community need to offset. Street Sweeping? Trash can receptacles?
- Cheri Not an issue on street sweeping
- Tom Retail? Should be located near hospital so patients can access it. Community won't utilize it
- Penny Areas of Controversy dust trucks hauling debris. They don't have an answer to dust mitigation
- John Noise vibration and dust within less that 100' where putting recuperative building Environmental pile of dirt nearby.
  - Diesel fumes and excessive noise and vibrations of trucks.
  - Cooling towers and exhaust stacks near residence
  - Residence w/in 125' of helipad
