CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

In order to safely install the new 54-inch diameter earthquake resistant pipeline and complete construction of the Foothill Trunk Line, traffic along Foothill Boulevard between Hubbard Street and Maclay Street will be limited to one-way southbound traffic for approximately twenty-four months.

detour route



NORTHBOUND DETOUR DETAILS

- · From January 2018 to December 2019, northbound traffic on Foothill Boulevard will be detoured at Maclay Street to Glenoaks Boulevard, north to Hubbard Street and back onto Foothill Boulevard.
- · Street parking is restricted along the active Work Area only.
- · Driveway access to homes and businesses will be maintained.
- · Traffic and street parking will be restored as each work area is completed.
- · Construction will occur Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. with the possibility of occasional work on Saturdays.



PROJECT BACKGROUND

The existing Foothill Trunk Line is a major transmission pipeline built in the 1930's and is responsible for transporting large amounts of water to the Sunland/Tujunga area. The improvements that will be completed under this project are necessary for the following reasons:

- Increased water capacity: Requires upsizing to 54-inch diameter pipe to accommodate future demands.
- · Improved system reliability: Replaces an aging steel pipe with a larger welded steel pipe and earthquake resistant ductile iron pipe.
