I-210 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION Project

THE I-210 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT EXTENDS FROM I-5 IN SYLMAR TO WHEATLAND AVE IN LAKE VIEW TERRACE.

The work totals \$135.5 million in construction capital and support costs. Construction is scheduled from summer 2020 through winter 2023/24.

The project spans 9.7 miles of I-210, which is a major commuter corridor and a vital route for the movement of goods in Los Angeles County. The heavily traveled roadway is cracked and needs pavement rehabilitation. This project will restore structural integrity and ride smoothness, as well as minimize maintenance needs and worker exposure.

PROJECT DETAILS

The I-210 Project will replace pavement on 52 lanes miles of I-210 from Wheatland Ave to Interstate 5 to provide a minimum service life of 40 years. The on and off-ramps, connectors and adjacent shoulders also will be rehabilitated, and slabs will be replaced where needed. Overhead sign structures, traffic loop detectors, center median barrier, and the guardrail system will be upgraded. The freeway lighting system and traffic signals at on and off-ramps will be improved. Existing curbs ramps will be upgraded where necessary to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

WHAT TO EXPECT

Multiple 55-Hour Extended Weekend Closures, that **include full freeway closures**, will occur on the project. Generally, all lanes will remain open to maintain freeway capacity, however, motorists are advised to plan for construction-related traffic delays. An auxiliary lane will be used to shift traffic patterns to perform pavement work. Some ramps may be closed for an extended period of time. The I-210/SR-118 and I-5/I-210 connector will also be closed along with local streets.

Travel speeds will be reduced to 55 MPH in the construction zone.

NOTE

Special provisions allow the contractor to close lanes or ramps for extended periods as needed.

OVERVIEW

- Replace pavement in both directions for smoother and safer ride.
- Reconstruct center median barrier and upgrade overhead signs. Update guardrails and signal lights.
- Construct stormwater treatment devices.
- Rehabilitate ramps, connectors and shoulders.
- Upgrade pedestrian curb ramps to standards of American with Disabilities Act (ADA).
- Project length: 9.7 miles
